



BEAI – Spectrum Journal Brief Guidelines for Authors

This leaflet is intended as a guide for authors preparing clinical articles for publication in the BEAI Spectrum.

1. Authors should submit the article title, author's name, full job title and place of practice at the top of the article, along with a profile picture where possible.
2. Each article should include a brief introduction.
3. Articles are 700 words per page. (2000 max)
4. At least three sub-headings within each article.
5. Maximum of three figures or three tables in each article and clearly marked
6. Images/photos should be 300 dots per inch (DPI) and graphs/tables should be high resolution with references or sources supplied where needed.
7. Images/photos and graphs/tables, should not be embedded in the text as these will not be used as they are too low resolution.
8. Picture captions should read: e.g. (l-r) Brian Kearney, Oleg Shrolik and Meabh Smith, Beaumont Hospital.
9. References should be clearly marked in the text in order and listed at the end of the article under References, in the Vancouver style.
10. Common Italian terms such as et al, in vitro/ in situ in regular font.
